The Electric Cooperative Youth Tour is an all-expense-paid trip to Washington, D.C., held June 17-23, 2022. Approximately 1,500 students from across the country gather to learn more about government and electric cooperatives and tour historic sights and museums.

Am I eligible?

Any high school junior whose parents or guardians are members of First Electric Cooperative may submit an application to enter the Youth Tour contest.

How do I enter?
