

What is Youth Tour?

The Electric Cooperative Youth Tour is an all-expenses-paid trip to Washington, D.C., held June 16-22, 2023. Approximately 1,500 students from across the country gather to learn more about government and electric cooperatives and tour historic sights and museums.

Am I eligible?

A high school junior whose parents or guardians are members of First Electric Cooperative may submit an application to enter the Youth Tour contest.
